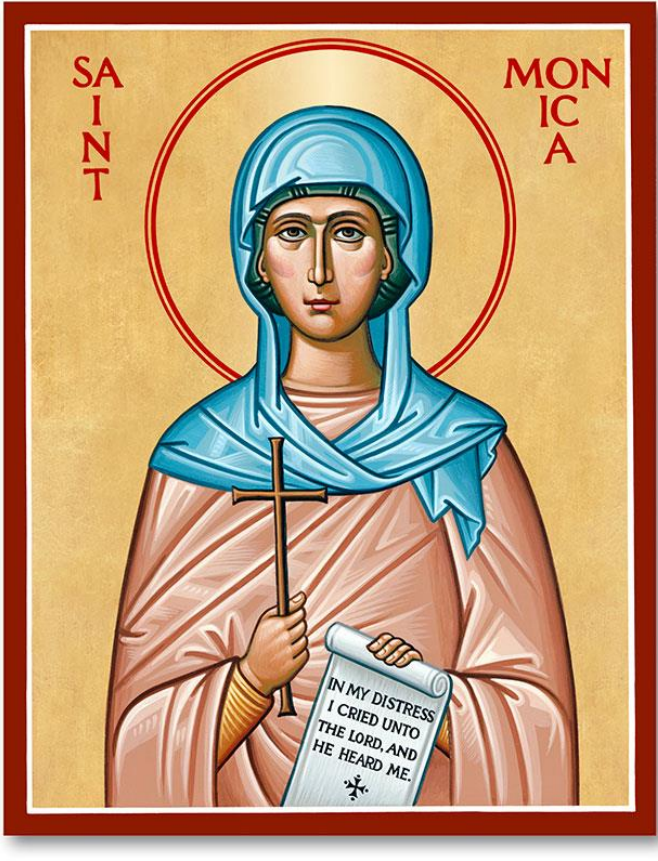
Lord God, our heavenly Father,

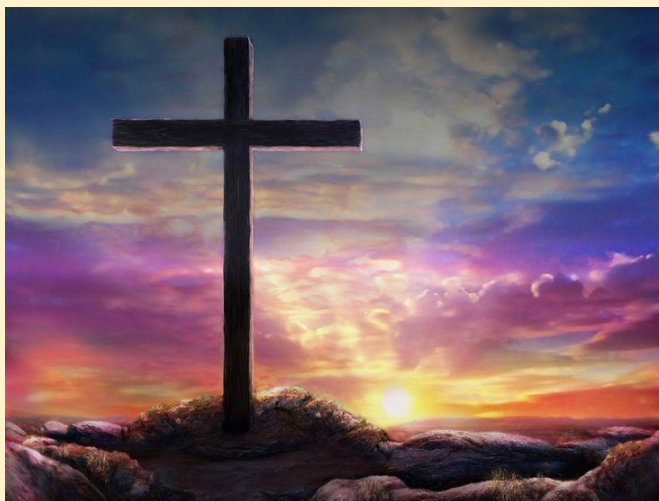

### A Prayer for Remembrance

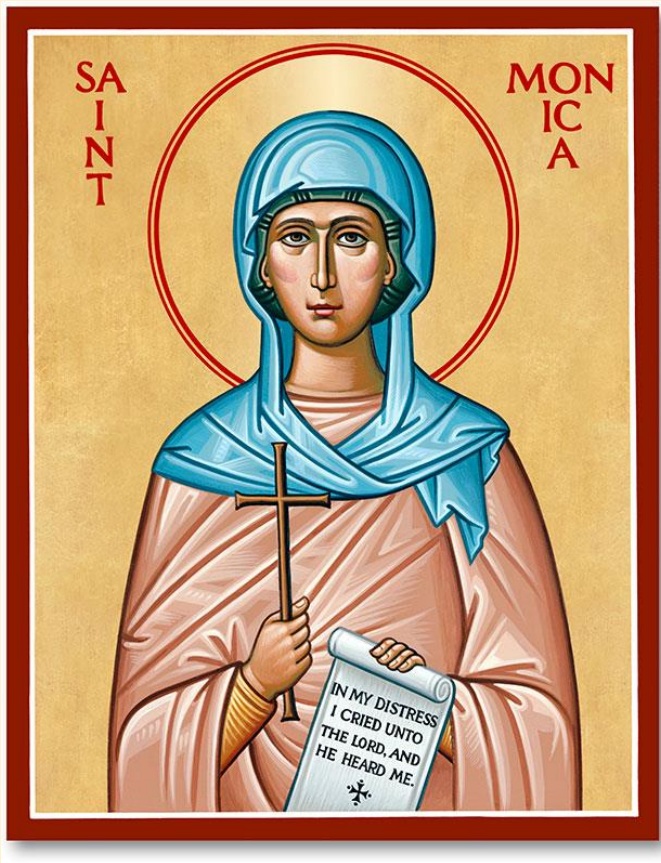
Ever-living God,

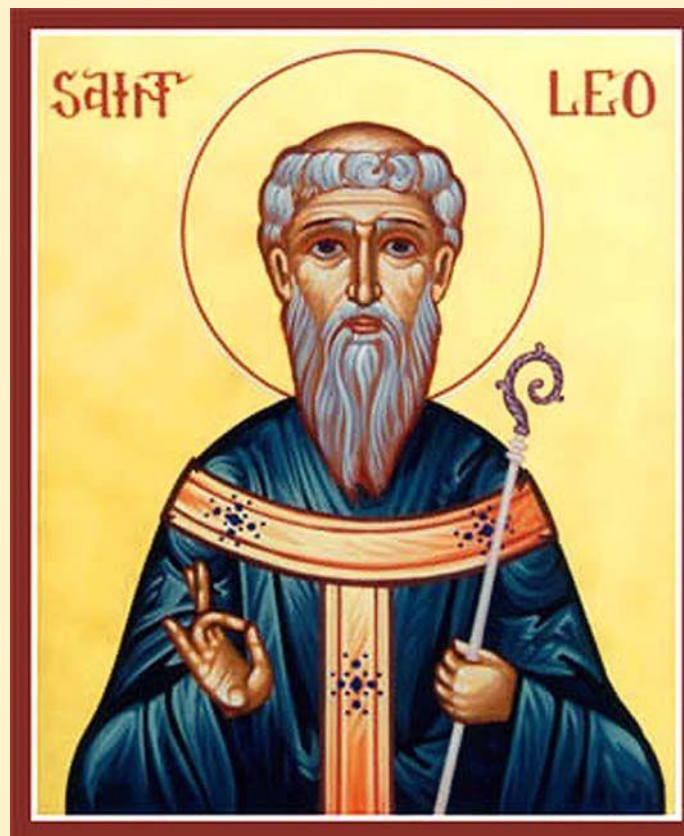


## Integrity
