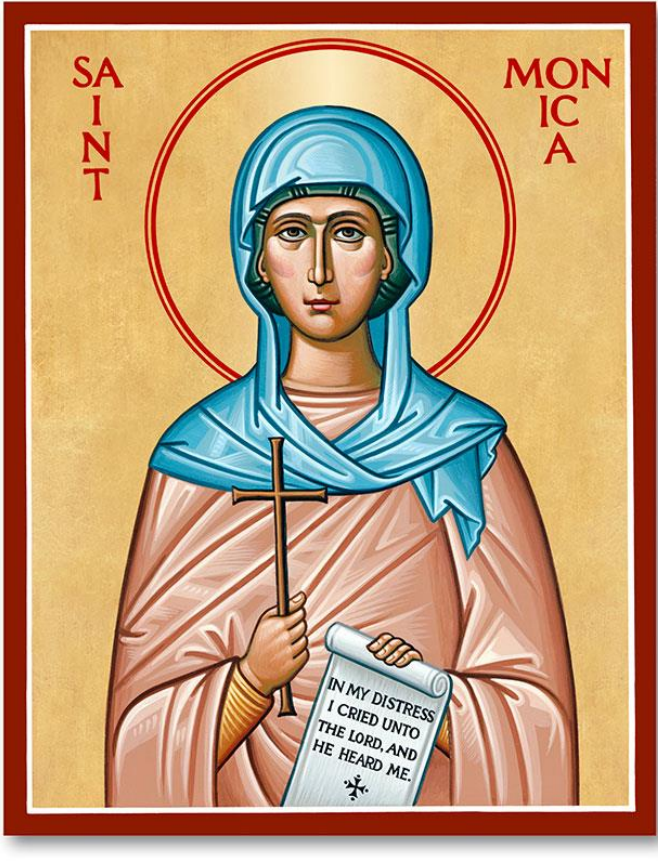

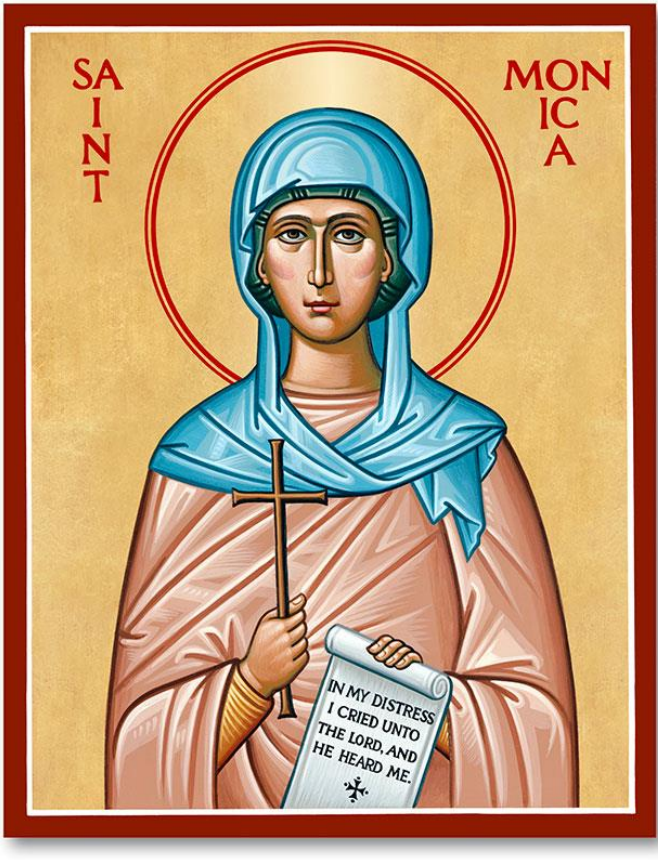
Dear Lord,
