Dear Year 11 Parent/Carer,

I hope this letter finds you well. This week you will receive your child's Spring Term report. The current working grades reflect the grades achieved in the recent Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs). These were shared with Year 11 pupils on Friday, and the focus over the next few lessons is a) recognising what pupils can do and b) identifying areas for improvement. There is still time to make a difference ahead of the Summer GCSE examinations.
