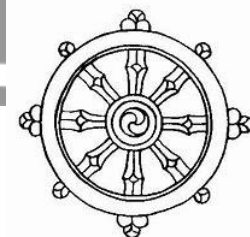


God's revelation through the **Holy Spirit**, sent by God, acts within the Church

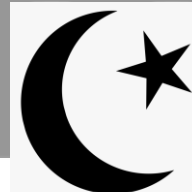
